RACTICE PHILOSOPHY

The goal of our health care practice is to provide the highest quality dentistry possible, while treating our patients with the highest standard of respect, compassion, and care. Our practice will concentrate on prevention and education using the highest standards of professionalism.



There are many types of dentistry today. Some people seek only emergency dentistry. In other words, they only seek care when they are in trouble or in pain. This type of dentistry is quite discouraging because most people who seek only emergency care lose their teeth by the time they are fifty years old.

About seventy percent of the practices in the country are totally oriented toward repair care of the teeth. They fix teeth one at a time as they break and when the gums bleed badly enough the teeth are cleaned. ATIENTS WITH DENTAL INSURANCE

We are pleased that you have a dental insurance plan and we will do everything we can to help you maximize your benefits. You may be interested in the following facts.

- 1) We ask that you understand that we do not work for the insurance companies, nor do we wish to. We work 100 percent for you. We want to maximize your benefits and we work hard to tailor your treatment plan to do this. We also refuse to be controlled by the insurance companies. When this happens the patient always loses. Most insurance companies will cover about 50-80 percent of the total fee on a truly high quality treatment plan.
